From the Treasurer, Michael Dunemann

The Management Committee has recently adopted a budget for 2020/2021, after working through 2 draft iterations over the last three months. This is a balanced cash budget with Income and Expenditure of \$315,000. Income from Subscriptions has been estimated at \$95,800 with an increase of \$40 for Full Members to \$840. A discount of 5% is available for payment in full by 31 March 2021.

Expenditure for the Course and Machinery has been set at \$234,200. It is worth noting that this level of expenditure is \$40,000 less than in 2014 and this really does reflect the challenges the Club has faced in that period with the golf course. The budget is heavily reliant on income from the Golf Classic and casual golfers via green fees and cart hire. The Club did achieve a significant surplus last financial year and was able to purchase a new Greens mower outright, and this has assisted the budget for this year.

From the Course Manager: Cory Keenan

The Course has come through the summer and is in typical condition for this time of year, with dry fairways etc. Members will see the course improve steadily from now on as the days get shorter and the irrigation system has better affect. I have been back at the Club for a month now and will over the next few months work through a review of all aspects of course and machinery maintenance. This process has commenced, and the new Course Committee will assist with this. I pay tribute to Bob Crabtree, staff and volunteers for the manner in which the course has come through the last few years. I understand this has been a challenge. The Autumn renovation of the greens will be done 23 March. It is expected that the greens will be in excellent condition for the 1st round of the Club Championship.
